But, it is that time of the year again when Mother Nature carries the heat wave across the San Joaquin Valley. Therefore, hydrated and always have a bottle of sunscreen handy.

Here at the golf course, the maintenance crews are busy doing lots of hand watering, installing additional sprinklers, pruning and removing trees and correcting areas with insufficient drainage.

Next thing coming up is the over seeding of the right rough of hole # 14 and left rough of hole # 10. With the addition of sprinkler heads it will be much easier for the Bermuda grass to be established.

The bunker at # 18 hole (green side) will be evaluated and corrected for better conditions. The ground squirrel situation has been taken care of at an early stage this year and with the great success, we hope to be ground squirrel free for a few months.

A quick note from your Superintendent: Cart etiquette, like fixing ball marks and replacing divots is a responsibility all golfers share. Please obey all cart instructions and restrictions. Thank you and stay cool!!
